ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS:

Approval of the August 20, 2015 Board Meeting Minutes:

Ms. Smith seconded by Mr. Shaw made a motion to approve the August 20, 2015 Board Meeting Minutes as written. The motion carried unanimously.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Tracy Naff, Compliance

Ms. Naff reviewed the probationary report with the Board. Ms. Naff stated that all probationers were compliant.

Appointments

Jason Blagman "NOAA"

Mr. Blagman appeared before the Board for his scheduled appointment. Ms. Johansen reviewed his offense and response from Mr. Blagman's Notice of Agency Action. Mr. Blagman explained the circumstances that led to his conviction.

Mr. Wright made a motion to revoke Mr. Blagman's license. Motion died.

Ms. Smith seconded by Mr. Shaw made a motion to suspend Mr. Blagman's license for 12 months. Four members voted in favor. Mr. Wright and Sheriff Richardson opposed. Motion carried.

Chief Giles seconded by Mr. Shah then made a motion to approve a probationary license for Mr. Blagman's Armed Security Officer license for 6 months after the 12 month suspension. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Shaw seconded by Ms. Smith made a motion to have Mr. Blagman's Memorandum be the standard conditions of a probationary license. The Motion carried unanimously.

Nicholas Carter "NOAA"

Mr. Carter appeared before the Board for his scheduled appointment. Mr. Hansen the investigator on the case explained the circumstances of his conviction.

Chief Giles seconded by Mr. Shah made a motion to put Mr. Carter on a standard probationary license as an Unarmed Security Officer until February, 2017, when his probation with the courts is final and it was deemed a successful Plea and Abeyance. Five members voted in favor. Ms. Smith opposed. Motion carried.

Bradley Wardle, Application Review

Mr. Wardle appeared before the Board for his scheduled appointment. Ms. Johansen reviewed the application which included criminal offenses. Mr. Wardle explained the circumstances that led to his offenses.

Chief Giles seconded by sheriff Richardson made a motion to approve a probationary license as an Unarmed Security Officer for the duration of his court probation then Mr. Wardle could apply for an Armed Security Officer License. The motion carried unanimously.

Clifford Cardall, Application Review

Mr. Cardall appeared before the Board for his scheduled appointment. Mr. Cardall was seeking to be the Qualifying Agent for Wasatch Protective Services. Mr. Cardall reviewed his experience with the Board.

Mr. Wright seconded by Sheriff Richardson made a motion to approve Mr. Cardall as the Qualifying Agent for Wasatch Protective Services. The motion carried unanimously.

Mint Phillips, Application Review

Mr. Phillips appeared before the Board for his scheduled appointment. Ms. Johansen reviewed the application with the Board. Mr. Phillips explained the circumstances that led to his offenses.

Sheriff Richardson seconded by Ms. Smith made a motion to deny Mr. Phillips as an Unarmed Security Officer License due to the fact that the court case has not gone through yet. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board noted that they could reconsider approving a license after the court's decision.

Michael Diaz, Application Review

Mr. Diaz did not appear before the Board for his scheduled appointment. Ms. Johansen reviewed his application which included offenses.

Sheriff Richardson seconded by Chief Giles made a motion to deny Mr. Diaz a license as an Unarmed Security Office. The motion carried unanimously.
